


Post-secondary Attainment:

Re-engaging high school graduates and adult learners is a key objective in pursuit of post-secondary attainment goal.




Attainment by Year

WA's state and pierce county's post-secondary attainment rate (for adults with associate's degree or higher) has increased steadily in the most recent years.








2022 Post-secondary attainment rate (Associates degree and higher) by demographics




Enrollment

WA high school (HS) graduation rate has slightly increased while the HS to post-secondary enrollment rate has declined in recent years.



COVID Era Enrollment

The direct HS to post-secondary enrollment rate remains in the mid 50 percent and has not rebounded since COVID.
