Tribal Elder Tuition Waiver

Tribal Elders from Washington's 29 federally recognized Tribes who are age 55 or older can enroll at Tacoma Community College courses at a reduced rate. The Board waives 100 percent of tuition and service and activity fees for tribal elders over the age of 55 from eligible Indian tribes pursuant to [RCW 28B.15.541](#).

Federally recognized tribes include Chehalis Confederated Tribes, Colville Confederated Tribes, Cowlitz Tribe, Hoh Tribe, Jamestown S'Kallam Tribe, Kalispel Tribe, Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe, Lummi Nation, Makah Tribe, Muckleshoot Tribe, Nisqually Tribe, Nooksack Tribe, Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe, Puyallup Tribe, Quileute Tribe, Quinault Nation, Samish Nation, Sauk-Suiattle Tribe, Shoalwater Bay Tribe, Skokomish Tribe, Snoqualmie Tribe, Spokane Tribe, Squaxin Island Tribe, Stillaguamish Tribe, Suquamish Tribe, Swinomish Tribe, Tulalip Tribes, Upper Skagit Tribe, Yakama Nation Confederated Tribes
