The COVID-19 pandemic has created multiple changes for students preparing to apply to the TCC nursing program. Here is what we can tell you right now.

All admission criteria to the Tacoma Community College will not change as outlined on our web page and the admission packets except the following:

## What do I do if my Nursing Assistant Certification is delayed?

At the time of Application, students will need to submit one of the following for the NAC requirement as follows:

- Submission of an active Washington State NAC license
- Submission of passing scores of NAC skills and written tests from Pearson Vue (you also need to submit your NAC application to the Washington state Department of Health before the application cycle closes)

## Should I apply if I do not have all of my non-factored pre-requisites completed?

Yes, students who have one <u>non-factored</u> pre-requisite left, to be completed at the time of application, are encouraged to apply (examples-missing 5 Humanities Credits, CMST&210 etc.). If the program has admitted all qualified applicants and has additional capacity to admit students, we will look to fill these spaces with students who are closest to meeting requirements. If selected, these <u>students will still have to complete the final requirements</u> achieving the minimum grade required (C or higher) as this is a degree requirement.
