All complete application packets received by the deadline will be carefully screened by the selection committee and considered for attendance at the Paramedic Program Selection Conference.

The selection committee will review all complete applications by April 20th. Soon after, qualified applicants will be invited to attend the Paramedic Selection Conference, which will be scheduled in either late April/early May. The Paramedic Program Selection Conference will include an information session to explain the expectations of the program and will offer the opportunity for applicants to ask questions. During this time, applicants are expected to take the 100 question EMT basic knowledge written exam, and an EMT basic skills assessment. Remember, this is an EMT basic skills evaluation, and applicants will not be tested on any paramedic level knowledge. Specific information regarding the written exam and skills assessment will be provided to qualified applicants prior to the Paramedic Selection Conference. Tacoma Community College does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, marital status, or disability.

TCC's Paramedic Education Program is designed to prepare graduates to meet State certification requirements, as well as to take the National Registry EMT-Paramedic examination. Upon successful completion of the certificate program, students have the option to pursue an **Associate in Applied Sciences** degree by completing 42 additional credits of general education courses as outlined in the curriculum. Those classes may also be taken prior to beginning the Paramedic Education program.

To be eligible to apply, candidates must be at least 18 years of age; possess a current EMT certification; have a minimum of one-year experience working as an EMT prior to the application deadline; be fluent in the English language; and possess the physical abilities and emotional stability to complete the program.

- I have included documentation of at least **ONE YEAR** of active EMT experience **ON LETTERHEAD STATIONERY** from the agency(s) where applicant works (or has worked) as an EMT by no later than May 1st. This document should include **total years** working as an EMT. Please do not include additional letters of reference or recommendation with your application as they are not factored into the admission process.
- I have provided **official or unofficial transcripts** from all colleges previously attended.
- I have submitted documentation that shows **successful completion of the English and Math requirements for admission** through official or unofficial transcripts OR through placement testing.

Transcript must show:

English 101 or greater **and** Math 90 or greater with grade of C or better.

OR

Assessment exam placement:

English 95 or greater **and** Math 85 or greater
