HOUSING PROGRAM

Complete Homestay \$675 / month

A furnished private room, with internet access in the student’s bedroom, utilities, and three meals per day provided by the host. Breakfast and lunch prepared by the student, dinner prepared by the host.

Bed & Breakfast Homestay \$525 / month

A furnished private room, utilities, and breakfast. The host provides food for breakfast: for all other meals. Students purchase and prepare their own food.

AIRPORT PICK UP

A TCC representative meets arriving students at the airport and takes them directly to their new homes.
