TCC Homestay Program

Our in-house Homestay program seeks the best families in Tacoma to host our international students. TCC International Staff will thoroughly vet each family and ensure they live no further than a 30-minute busride or walking commute from campus.

Homestay has two offerings: Complete (with three meals/day) or Shared (no meals included)

Airport pick up during our arrival days is included at no cost with the TCC Homestay Program.

Local Apartment/House

Students who are 18 and older are eligible to live outside of the Homestay program in a local apartment or house. TCC Staff does not coordinate apartment placement, but there are many options surrounding campus and throughout the city at varying prices.





At TCC, we provide services that fully support our students and make for a positive study experience.

ADVISING: Academic advisors help students choose the right classes to stay on track for graduation. International advisors also provide immigration advising to ensure all international students stay instatus.


