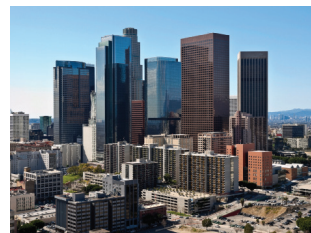
WHERE IS CSUN?

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS*

For freshmen

- Completion of the equivalent to a U.S. high school diploma
- Equivalent to a U.S. grade point average (GPA) of 3.0
- Minimum scores: TOEFL 61 / IELTS 5.5
- Original or certified copies of all official secondary records, including certificates, degrees or diplomas in the original language of issue
- Official English translations of all academic records, including certificates, degrees or diplomas

For graduate students

- Completion of the equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree
 - Minimum scores: TOEFL 79 / IELTS 6.0
 - Original or certified copies of all official records
 - Official English translations of all academic records
- Note: Individual graduate programs may require separate applications and supporting material. Please contact the appropriate department (visit www.csun.edu/academic).

For transfer students

- Completion of the four general education requirements: written communications, critical thinking, speech and college-level math
- Equivalent to a U.S. grade point average (GPA) of 2.0
- Official transcripts from all community colleges attended

HOW TO APPLY

1. Review application procedures and document requirements at www.csun.edu/anr/intl. In the "Topics" menu, go to "I Want to Apply" for deadlines and instructions.
2. Go to www.csumentor.edu. Use the "Apply Online" tab, then go to "International Admission Applications."
3. Mail official documents to: California State University, Northridge International Admissions and Evaluations 1811 Nordhoff St. Northridge, CA 91330-8207
4. If your native language is not English, submit the results of your Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or other English language proficiency exam. To find out if you are exempt from a language proficiency exam, visit www.csun.edu/anr/intl.
5. Submit an Affidavit of Financial Support (available at www.csun.edu/anr/forms/affidavit.pdf) with a bank statement.

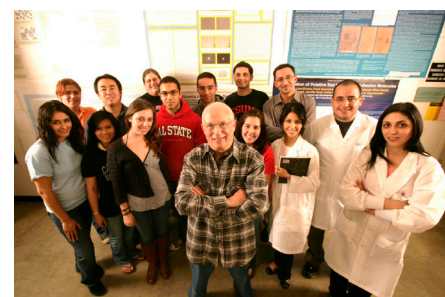
