

- Original or certified copies of all official secondary records, including certificates, degrees or diplomas in the original language of issue

For graduate students

- Completion of the equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree
- IELTS 6.0
- Original or certified copies of all official records
- Official English translations of all academic records Note: Individual graduate programs may require separate applications and supporting material. Please contact the appropriate department (visit www.csun.edu/academic).

For transfer students

- Completion of the four general education requirements: written communications, critical thinking, speech and college-level math
- Equivalent to a U.S. grade point average (GPA) of 2.0
- Official transcripts from all community colleges attended
